Deletion of mediaBlackPointTag

1. Introduction

The mediaBlackPointTag is an optional tag which is intended to be used to specify the media black point. In practice, this tag has not been implemented (either for profile generators or consumers) well or at all. In addition, there is more than a single useful method to calculate the media black point, hence a single tag such as this is insufficient anyways. There are no known CMMs which make use of the mediaBlackPointTag.

It is desired to delete the mediaBlackPointTag from the ICC profile specification in order to simplify the specification's use. Going forward, the mediaBlackPointTag will be treated as a private tag.

2. The acceptance of this proposal will result in a:

Minor revision of Specification ICC.1:2004-10

3. Nature of the proposal

This is a **new technical addition** to the specification(s).

The specification of the mediaBlackPointTag is proposed to be deleted from the ICC profile specification.

4. Votable Proposal

Delete section 9.2.24 and renumber the successive sections.

Change procedure (5) described in section D.6.2 as follows:

5. Record the converted media white point in the mediaWhitePointTag.

Delete second row (mediaBlackPointTag) in Table G.13
